Camper registrations are coming in at a frenzied pace. We are eager to serve as many campers as possible during our extended summer camp season. We have added 2 weeks of camp this year. We will be providing 6 weeks of Rhodes Grove camp. We added a week of Paintball Camp and week of

Extreme Camp that will take our campers hiking, biking and white water rafting. We will continue to offer 3 Traditional Resident Camps, Day Camp, Swim Camp and 4 Equestrian Camps. That totals 11 programs in 6 weeks...The pace will be furious, the days will be long, the work will be hard and prayerfully, the fruits of the labor will be much!

As I sit back and see this unfolding, I'm convinced of a few things.

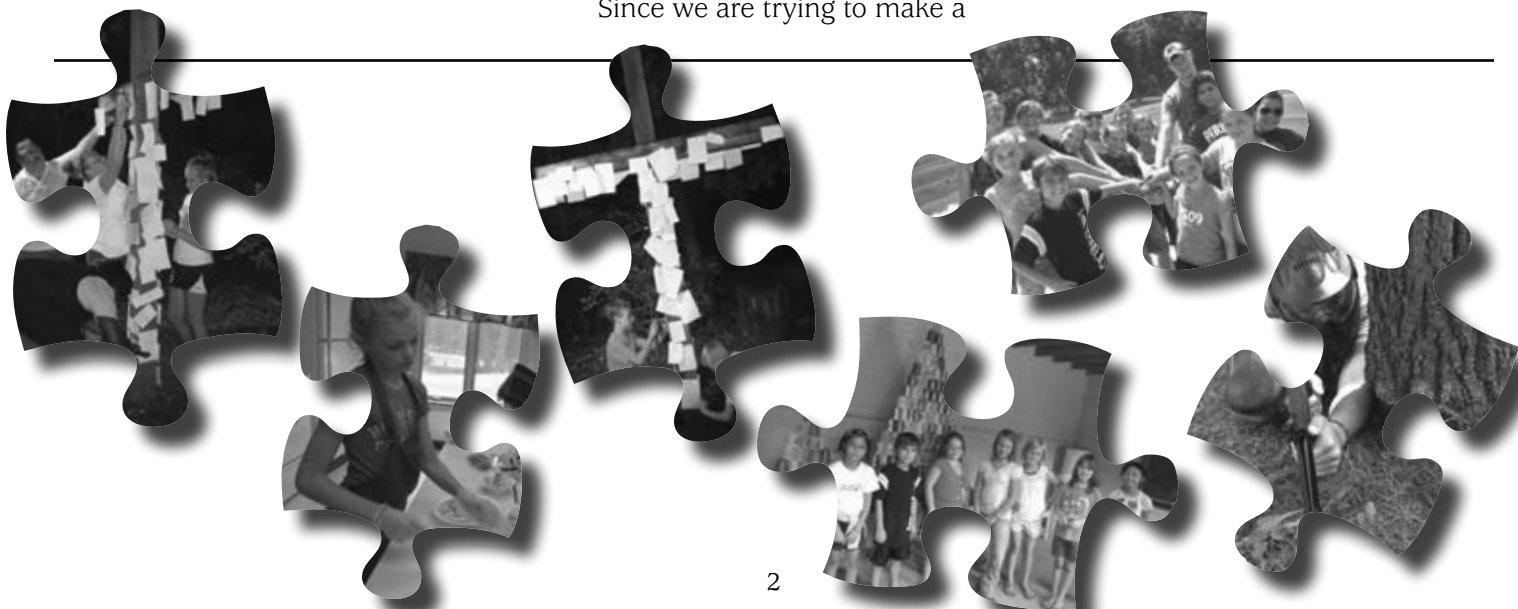
1. God is in control of Rhodes Grove Camp. This camp is His camp and the staff that works here simply has the privilege of watching Him work in miraculous ways.
