Necessary facility improvements, equipment additions and, when possible, land acquisition, will position Rhodes Grove to continue offering Christ centered experiences that reveal God's majesty. The campaign is planned to be active through 2017. Plan your participation now. Watch for continued updates on our website. We are currently celebrating commitments of \$253,004.88 raised towards the \$1.5 million goal.

**Advancing Tabernacle Faith** is proactively preparing Rhodes Grove for future ministry. There are three primary goals towards which partnership is needed.

**VICTORY GOAL . . . . . \$ 750,000**

Eliminate debt. This will release \$44,000 per year to enhance current ministry.

**CHALLENGE GOAL . . . . . \$1,000,000**

Achieving this threshold will allow a new horse barn, buy a necessary tractor and related equipment to continue to build the popular equestrian program.

**FAITH GOAL . . . . . \$1,500,000**

This goal demonstrates the testimony of our collective Tabernacle Faith! With these resources, such things as improving the HVAC units, facility upgrades, provide Adventure elements, climbing wall, stairs to the zip line, king swing, walk-in freezer, truck, mower and large capacity vans will become a reality.

Another possibility exists with the purchase of adjoining land to provide options for future ministry.
