

SCHEDULE

- Interns would be asked to work a 40 hour a week work week, dependent upon the needs of the camp, and the Ministry Directors schedule.
- Interns would be expected to work a full summer schedule.
- Interns would get 2weeks off for Christmas.
- 1 week off in the spring.
- 1 week off in the fall.
- 3 days for thanksgiving.
- 3 days for easter
- Interns would observe all holidays when the camp office is closed.
- Daily schedule would be lenient, upon prior approval of ministry director.
- Interns may be asked to work evenings, or weekends.
- If an intern travels for recruiting or speaking and arrives home after 5 pm, they would not be expected to begin work until 12pm the following day.

Overview

4 areas of development

This program is designed to equip the next generation of leaders in 4 main areas, Spiritually, Vocationally, Socially, and Recreationally. This program can be offered to any high school student looking to do a co-op, college student, or graduate student. The program can be offered at a 10-15 week summer internship, 6 month internship, or a 12 month internship.

Housing: 6 and 12 month interns will stay in winterized area of camp, with other areas of camp. Summer interns will stay in staff cottages.

Meals: Interns will be able to eat all meals provided when summer camps, and guests are being served in our dining hall.

When meals are not provided, full time staff will provide a meal for interns.

Payment: (all interns will be paid for summer camp. rate dependent upon upon position.)

Intern pay is deteremined upon needs of the student.

Miscellaneous:

-Interns would be given a desk, and work area, located in ministry directors office.

- Have availability to a camp computer, but could use personal computer if they would like.

- Be assigned an RGC email.

Spiritually

Each day our interns will be challenged and encouraged through The reading of God's word. The interns will be taught and led by the Ministry Director, and local pastors and Bible College Professors.

Vocationally

Our 6 and 12 month interns will not just focus on 1 main area of camping ministry, they will lean each area of camping, Operations, Guest services, Programing, food services. This will teach them the professional side of camp. They will have a main focus area (Ideally programming), but will learn all aspects of camp.

Our 12-15 week summer interns will be focusing on 1 area of camp, Worship, program, Counseling, Kitchen.

Socially

Through the time at camp, the intern is on the property they will be able to grow Relationally. They will be interacting with parents, guests, campers, speakers, pastors, staff, church and community leaders.

Recreationally

One of the coolest aspects of camp, is that we are saturated with youth and games, and the ability to engage in new activities, and have experiences, that an intern may not be able to experience at home. This area they will grow in their recreation abilities and be able to perform more tasks for the future.
