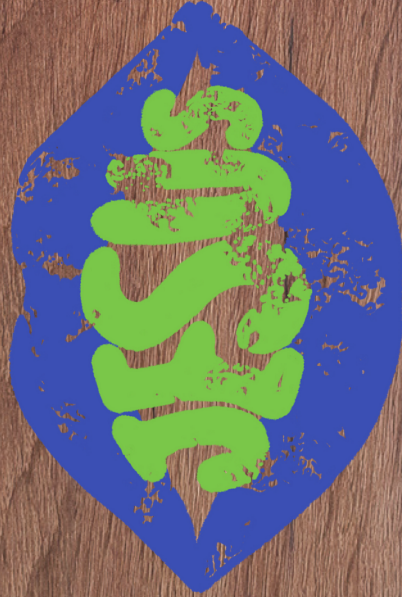


Where is RGC?

Day Camp

A week of camp only during the day for children between the ages of six and nine is offered June 30 – July 3, 2024. This camp runs daily that week from 8 AM to 4 PM. As a camper you will enjoy Bible lessons, lunch, games, crafts and more as you move forward in your Christian faith.

Grades are based on grade recently completed. And age is based on age at the beginning of camp.

Equestrian Camps

Mustangs & Mavericks – The highlight of the week will be an overnight trail ride and sleeping under the stars with old and new friends. Designed for intermediate riders to increase their riding skills. A minimum 15 hours of previous horse experience is required.

Wild Wind – Designed for advanced trail riders looking for the ultimate equestrian adventure, who are comfortable with tacking and mounting their horse independently. This rustic adventure will include three days of trail riding, with two nights sleeping in a tent, Dutch oven cooking, trail games and outdoor chapel by a fire. The camp allows riders to see the glory of God's creation while on horseback. Elements of the trail can be challenging, so riders must have previous horse camp (or equivalent) experience.

Equestrian Experience – In addition to usual horsemanship experiences, this camp develops, practices, and then performs on Saturday morning a synchronized program for the public.
