

## Family Camp 2025: Things you should know:



Swimming Pool	We are working hard on our swimming pool. Unfortunately, our pool will not be open during Family Camp. We anticipate the pool will be open and ready for our summer camps. Please remember that this is an active worksite. Please be sure your children do not enter the worksite for any reason. Thank you for being understanding and flexible.
Swimming Pool Bathhouse	Our bathhouse at the swimming pool will not be operational for Family Camp. Showers and bathrooms are available in the Retreat Center and the Upper Bathhouse. Thank you for understanding and being flexible.
Talent Show	This year, we will have a Talent Show on Sunday evening. All talents and ages are welcome to participate. The sign-up sheet will be available at the registration area.
Campfire Testimonies	We will be having a campfire on Sunday evening in Tabernacle Field. This is a time when we can come together and praise God for what He has and is doing in our lives. You don't want to miss this encouraging and uplifting time.
Offering for the Pool Project and Summer Campers	We will be taking an offering on Sunday evening at the campfire gathering. These funds will go toward our Pool Project and our Summer Camp financial aid for campers needing assistance.
Bikes	Please, no bikes inside the buildings

Canoe Trip	Weather permitting, we will meet in front of Kauffman Lodge at 1 pm to canoe down Conococheague Creek on Saturday and Sunday. Cost is \$5/person and can be paid during the run. An adult must accompany kids (10 and under). Wear old clothes and shoes (sandals are ok, no slip-ons, flip-flops, or bare feet). You WILL get wet! Life jackets are available for all. Life jackets are required to be worn by everyone 12 years and younger, according to PA law. Sign up at the front office.
Dogs	Thank you for requesting permission to have your dog on campus. Dogs must be leashed at all times. Thank you for cleaning up after your dog.

First Aid Kits	First Aid Supplies are available at the Front Desk for minor first aid needs. First aid kits are in the kitchenette, Kauffman Lodge, and the Retreat Center.
Registration Hours	Friday 6:00-7:30 pm, Saturday and Sunday 8:30- noon, Monday 8:30- Noon. For assistance, you may call the number posted at the front desk.
Pony Rides	Offered Saturday & Sunday afternoon for children of all ages (at least 1 year old). Riders must wear shoes (no sandals). Pony rides are given at the lower corral, are free of charge, and offered on a first-come, first-served basis.

Quiet Hours	Please “love thy neighbor” by honoring the 10:30 pm to 7:00 am quiet hours. Keep music to a minimum volume level at all times. Thanks!
Retreat Center	The Retreat Center will be open from 7:00 am to 9:30 pm. The Retreat Center will be closed during all Chapel services. Guests will be lodging in the Retreat Center. Please do not enter lodging areas. Please put the equipment back where it belongs. Thanks!
Rubber Ducky Race	Rubber ducks will race down Muddy Run Creek Sunday at 4:00 pm. Each duck costs \$5 and can be purchased at the registration table in the front office.
Schedule	Please refer to your schedule for all activity times. Services will begin on time. We ask that you be prompt. Thank You!
Tournaments	Please see the daily schedule for start times of our various tournaments. Tournaments to include Disc golf, horseshoes, carpetball, ping pong, and cornhole for all ages. Sign up at the front office.
Trail Rides	1/2-hour trail ride around grounds will be offered Saturday & Sunday to those with previous riding experience. Cost is \$5.00. Sign-up sheets are at the registration table in the lobby. Riders will meet at the horse corral. Riders must wear jeans and boots and complete the two release forms available at the Registration Desk.
Waterslide	Footwear is not permitted on the water slide except for water shoes. One-piece swimwear must be worn. No everyday outerwear will be allowed. Swimwear cannot have buttons or decorative attachments that will puncture or tear the slide.
What to wear	Please always wear shoes (the only exception is when using the waterslide). No immodest clothes. One-piece bathing suits only.
Zip line	Riders must be at least 10 years old or in 4 <sup>th</sup> grade. Sneakers and dry clothing must be worn. Kids (10-12) must have a parent/caregiver present.
